#### Desmond a chance to live

We have said many times that rescues are so full of 'unwanted' dogs that genuine cases struggle to find a place. Des is one such dog, he is nine years old and has been with his owner from being a pup.

His owner has to undergo a long and painful treatment and has nobody able to look after Des, he has been forced to part with his beloved pet to ensure that whatever happens, his dog will be looked after. We made a space for Des and we will find him a loving home, he spent a few nights fretting but he will be fine. His owner cried unashamedly when he brought him in, not just for the sad parting but because with rescues refusing him a place due to being full and an older dog (yes that happens) he was terrified that with 3 days left to being hospitalised he would have to have his pet euthanised. Yet many selfish thoughtless people put their dogs into rescue for reasons that beggar belief. Genuine cases should not be refused a place because rescues are full of dogs that their owners just don't want anymore.
